

CALIFORNIA TRANSPARENCY IN SUPPLY CHAIN ACT OF 2010  
JKL POSITION STATEMENT

On January 1, 2012, The California Transparency in Supply Chain Act (SB 657), became effective. The Act requires manufactures and retailers doing business in the State of California to issue a statement to disclose what efforts and commitments they are making to prevent slavery and human trafficking within the supply chain.

The Act only imposes posting requirements on companies that have annual worldwide gross receipts exceeding one hundred million dollars. Although JKL is not required to declare our position, JKL is committed to making efforts in support of positive change.

Should JKL identify a supplier that fails to comply with laws associated with human rights violations and/or if a supplier knowingly does business with parties associated with ethical misconduct or procurement of conflict materials, contracts will be subject to immediate termination.
